

Seerah - The Quriash try to Kill the Messenger of Allaah and the Conversion of Hamza bin Abdul Muttalib and Umar bin Al Khattab

Aaliyah is enjoying the study of Muhammad ﷺ, are you enjoying it too? Now remember the good King Najjashi looked after some of the Muslims but in Makkah there were many Muslims including the Messenger of Allaah ﷺ who did not migrate to Abyssinia who were all harmed a lot by the Quraish.
